Thank you for your electronic submittal dated April 3, 2019, transmitting documentation that Harvest Four Corners (Harvest) has completed the screening procedures to address threatened and endangered species (TES) and historic properties for the installation of new equipment for natural gas compression at the Ojito Compressor Station under the Federal Implementation Plan for True Minor Sources in Indian Country in the Oil and Natural Gas Production and Natural Gas Processing Segments of the Oil and Natural Gas Sector. In accordance with 40 CFR 49.104(a)(2), you must obtain written confirmation from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency that you have satisfactorily addressed the procedures before submitting the Part 1 General Facility Information registration form at least 30 days prior to beginning construction.

This letter serves as written confirmation that Harvest has satisfactorily completed the screening procedures to address TES and historic properties for the installation of the new equipment at the Ojito Compressor Station located on Indian country lands within the Jicarilla Apache Nation Reservation. The documentation submitted supports your findings that no federally-listed TES or their designated critical habitat(s) are likely to occur within the action area of your source (Criterion A of the screening procedures) and that no historic properties will be affected.
