

Registration Review Update

May 8-9, 2019 Pesticide Program Dialogue Committee Meeting

Registration Review is a statutory mandate contained in FIFRA Section 3(g)

- Requires review of each registered pesticide every 15 years
 - Scope – ~725 “cases” encompassing over 1,100 pesticide active ingredients (A.I.) across conventional, antimicrobial, and biopesticides
- EPA must complete review of all pesticides registered as of October 1, 2007 by October 1, 2022

Registration Review Progress Across OPP (Total as of Q2 FY19)

- 483 Draft Risk Assessments completed (~33% remaining)
- 327 Proposed Interim Decisions complete (~45% remaining)
- 386 Final or Interim Decisions complete (~53% remaining)

FY19 Registration Review Deliverables for Conventional Chemicals

- 55 Draft Risk Assessments anticipated (16 completed as of FY19 Q2)
- 55 Proposed Interim Decisions anticipated (23 completed as of FY19 Q2)
- 55 Interim Decisions anticipated (20 completed in FY19 Q2)

2019 High Profile Draft Risk Assessments and Decisions

- Neonicotinoids (Imidacloprid, Clothianidin, Thiamethoxam and Dinotefuran)
 - 2016/2017: Draft risk assessments published, including pollinators
 - 2018: Consider public comments submitted, revise risk assessments based on new data and comments
 - 2019: Plan to publish proposed interim decisions for public comment
 - 2020: Plan to publish interim decisions
- Glyphosate
 - 2017: Draft risk assessments published
 - 2018: Consider public comments submitted, revise risk assessments based on new data and comments
 - 2019: Proposed interim decision published in April
 - 2020: Plan to publish interim decision
- Pyrethroids
 - 2016/2017: Draft risk assessments published
 - 2018: Consider public comments submitted, revise risk assessments based on new data and comments
 - 2019: Plan to publish proposed interim decisions
 - 2020: Plan to publish interim decisions
- Paraquat
 - 2019: Plan to publish draft risk assessments
- Structural/Commodity Fumigants
 - 2018/2019: Plan to publish draft risk assessments
 - 2020/2021: Plan to publish proposed interim decisions
 - 2021/2022: Plan to publish interim decisions
