An engaging, hands-on and standards-aligned curriculum focused on water.

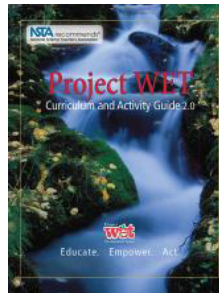
