Attached are the final FY 2018 and FY 2019 Assistance to Small and Disadvantaged Communities Tribal Grant Regional Allotments. Congress authorized this grant program under section 2104 of the Water Infrastructure Improvements for the Nation Act (WIIN Act). The final, post-rescission amount available for this program is \$42,854,000. The final, post-rescission tribal allotment available for this program is \$875,000. Attached are the regional allotment amounts available to support tribal water systems.

The grant implementation document will be released this summer. Regions will be notified when the implementation document is available and will develop regional processes to identify eligible activities and recipients and administer funding according to the guidelines outlined in the implementation document.
