


#### **GreenChill and Industry Potential**

#### GreenChill partner companies account for about 29% of all stores


If every U.S. supermarket met GreenChill Partners' 2018 average emission rate (13.9%), the supermarket industry would:

- Reduce annual refrigerant emissions by 30 million metric tons carbon dioxide equivalent
- Save \$156 million in annual refrigerant replacement costs



# Partnership Climate Impact per Store




## A Changing Industry


CFCs	Phased out
HCFCs	Being phased out; declining in use Mainly R-22 GWP 1820 ODPs
HFCs	Declining in use R-404A and R-507A common Higher GWPs No ODPs
Lower-GWP HFCs	Increasing in use R-407A common Low GWPs No ODPs
Other Refrigerants	Emerging technologies CO <sub>2</sub> , Ammonia, HFOs, Hydrocarbons Lower GWPs No ODPs



# GreenChill Advanced Refrigeration Partnership Annual Achievements

Goal must be below leak rate achieved the year before


Many GreenChill partners demonstrate continually reduced emissions
