AMENDMENT TO ADD CHITOSAN TO THE MINIMUM RISK PESTICIDE INERT INGREDIENT LIST AT THE SAME TIME AS ADDING CHITOSAN TO THE MINIMUM RISK PESTICIDE ACTIVE INGREDIENT LIST

Re: PETITION TO LIST THE MATERIAL CHITOSAN CAS # 9012-76-4 ON THE US EPA FIFRA MINIMUM RISK PESTICIDE LIST 40 CFR 152.25(f)

Dear Assistant Administrator Dunn:

This letter is an amendment to the petition filed to the EPA in October of 2018 to add the substance commonly called chitosan, CAS # of 9012-76-4, to the EPA's Minimum Risk Pesticide Active Ingredient list.



This purpose of this amendment is to request chitosan be added to the list of **inert** ingredients on the EPA Minimum Risk Pesticide List, 40 CFR Part 152.25(f), in addition to, and at the same time as adding chitosan to the Minimum Risk Pesticide Active Ingredient list.

There are many common applications of chitosan as an inert ingredient such as when used as an adjuvant along with a different active ingredient pesticides, where the active performs the pesticidal function and chitosan performs an inert function. In the interest of efficiency of time and the agencies limited resources, we request with that chitosan be added to both (Minimum Risk Active and Inert) lists at the same time, in order to avoid the use of additional resources by doing so in separate actions.
