


SQG RE-NOTIFICATION REQUIRED IN 2021

- 3. Site Name:** Fields for Country and Zip Code.
- 4. Site Location Address:** Fields for Street Address, City/Town/Village, State, Country, and Zip Code. There is a checkbox for "Same as Location".
- 5. Site Mailing Address:** Fields for Street Address, City/Town/Village, State, Country, and Zip Code. There are checkboxes for Tribal and Municipal.
- 6. Site Land Type:** Fields for Private, County, District, Federal, and Tribal. Below this is a section for "American Industry Classification System (NAICS) Code(s) for the Site (at least 5-digit codes)" with boxes for C and D.

As the treatment, storage, or disposal facility (TSDF) helping manage your hazardous waste, we want to ensure our customers are aware of recent regulatory changes that impact small businesses. Under U.S. EPA's Hazardous Waste Generator Improvements Rule, small quantity generators (SQGs) are now required to re-notify every four years. To satisfy this requirement, SQGs need to update their Notification of RCRA Subtitle C Activities (Site Identification Form), also known as EPA Form 8700-12, or state equivalent* by

September 1, 2021
