GLSSP RFA Modification Notice

June 19, 2020

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency issued a Request for Applications soliciting applications from eligible organizations for approximately \$3 million to operate the Great Lakes Sediment Surveillance Program (GLSSP).

A modification of the Request for Applications was posted today:

- Page 21, lines 1, 3: language clarified to indicate that the information requested is pertaining to "you *or your institution.*" Period of information required changed from 2010-2019 to 2015-2019 to be consistent with p27.
- Page 27, line 7: "projects" changed to "awards".
