<a href="#">33 USC Ch. 52: Water Infrastructure Finance and Innovation</a>	Section 3095(6) identifies water recycling projects as eligible for WIFIA funding. <i>(A brackish or sea water desalination project, including chloride control, a managed aquifer recharge project, a water recycling project, or a project to provide alternative water supplies to reduce aquifer depletion.)</i>
<a href="#">Interim final WIFIA implementation rule, Credit Assistance for Water Infrastructure Projects</a>	In Section 35.10005 Definitions, the Project definition lists as an eligible activity: <i>“(5) A brackish or sea water desalination project, a managed aquifer recharge project, or a water recycling project.”</i>
<a href="#">WIFIA website</a>	Lists all eligible projects, including water recycling.
<a href="#">WIFIA Program Summary factsheet</a>	Provides a high-level summary of the WIFIA program. The list of eligible projects which includes water recycling projects.
<a href="#">WIFIA Program Handbook</a>	The WIFIA program handbook describes the requirements and procedures for obtaining WIFIA credit assistance and complying with WIFIA program rules and regulations. Information about eligible projects, including water recycling projects, is available in section 2.2 (pp. 12-13).
<a href="#">Webinars</a>	Most WIFIA webinars include introductory slides outlining the program eligibilities, including project eligibility.
<a href="#">Notice of Funding Availability</a>	The WIFIA program’s annual Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) includes a section of eligible projects (section III B in the FY 2020 NOFA) and a section on the Selection Criteria (section VII in the FY 2020 NOFA). For both FY 2020 and FY 2019, Water reuse and recycling is highlighted as a priority and given additional weight in the selection criteria scoring.
