Email Shannon and Carla to give us your email address (the one that you used to get your 365/Teams set up)


- This will be the account that we add to the Fall 2020 PPDC Team
- You will receive a Teams notification when you have been added




Open the Teams notification email and follow the link to the Teams

- Helpful hint if you use the web: bookmark the site so you don't have to keep looking for the invite email.




Navigation: (Left Panel) Chat Tab




Navigation: (Left Panel) Files Tab



Navigation: (Left Panel) Teams Tab




How are the Workgroups Organized in Teams?




- Every Team has a "General" channel, and every member of the team has access to it.
- Each workgroup also has its own channel
 - The channels are private so that only a member of a workgroup can access: You will only see the channels where you are a workgroup member




Navigation: The (Top Panel) "Posts" Tab




The (Top Panel) Files Tab: Uploading Files






Working on Documents in Teams (Cont'd)


