STIPULATED ORDER

WHEREAS, Plaintiff the United States of America ("United States"), Plaintiff-Intervenors the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality and West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection (collectively, "Plaintiff-Intervenors"), and Defendants Ergon-West Virginia, Inc. ("EWV") and Ergon Refining, Inc. ("ERI") (sometimes collectively, the "Defendants") are parties to a Consent Decree entered by this Court on December 31, 2003 ("Consent Decree"); WHEREAS, Paragraph 80 of the Consent Decree provides that non-material modifications to the Consent Decree may be made by agreement of the United States, Plaintiff-Intervenors and Defendants in writing; and

WHEREAS, the parties have agreed to certain non-material modifications to the reporting provisions of the Consent Decree for purposes of administrative efficiency;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is Ordered, Adjudged and Decreed as follows:

1. Paragraph 77, providing for the manner of certain Consent Decree

required notices and reporting, shall be revised to read as follows:

Notice. Unless otherwise provided herein, notifications to or 77. communications between the Parties shall be deemed submitted on the date they are postmarked and sent by U.S. Mail, postage pre-paid, except for notices under Section XIV (Force Majeure) and Section XV (Retention of Jurisdiction/Dispute Resolution) which shall be sent by overnight mail or by certified or registered mail, return receipt requested. Each report, study, notification or other communication of EWV and ERI shall be submitted as specified in this Consent Decree, with copies to EPA Headquarters and the Applicable EPA Region and the Applicable State Agency. If the date for submission of a report, study, notification or other communication falls on a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, the report, study, notification or other communication will be deemed timely if it is submitted the next business day. Except as otherwise provided herein, all reports, notifications, certifications, or other communications required or allowed under this Consent Decree to be submitted or delivered to the United States, EPA, the State(s), EWV and ERI shall be addressed as provided in this Paragraph. Other than state air permit applications (¶¶ 19, 20, and 22), petitions to the court to invoke dispute resolution (¶ 54-62), and stipulated penalty payments (¶ 46), EWV and ERI may submit Consent Decree submissions electronically, rather than by U.S. Mail, postage pre-paid, overnight mail or registered mail, return receipt requested,, where an e-mail address is provided below. Electronic submissions will be deemed submitted on the date they are transmitted electronically and only one electronic submission is required per recipient (to address instances in which the Consent Decree requires that two hard copies be submitted per recipient).
