The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is taking public comment and holding a public hearing on plans for cleanup of contaminated sediment in the Acid Brook Delta/Uplands section of Pompton Lake related to the DuPont Pompton Lakes Works site. There are two ways to submit comments. Attend EPA's January 5 public hearing where your comments will be recorded, or submit written comments to EPA through January 13, 2012. After the close of public comment, EPA will consider all comments and decide whether to finalize the cleanup proposal and issue a permit modification that would legally require DuPont to perform the cleanup.
