- U.S. EPA: Is there an app for this?
 - o **Antony Williams:** 760,000 chemicals are plugged in as an iPhone and iPad app you can download. However, it is out of date by about a year and does not have the full list. You can get to the full website from the app.
- Michigan Department of Health and Human Services: Are there thousands of PFAS chemicals?
 - Antony Williams: If you go to the application and go to the chemical lists page, and type in PFAS, you will find that we have 23 different PFAS lists. These are chemicals that have been through in vitro screening, and we have registered over 7,000 PFAS; these come from different sources. When we do not have experimental data, we predict properties. In the past three weeks, we have harvested data from the literature and added 300,000 more data points which will be used to predict properties.
