The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) hereby **amends** the public health exemption authorized on January 14, 2021, under the provisions of Section 18 of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) to the Georgia Department of Agriculture for use of triethylene glycol (CAS No. 112-27-6); formulated as Grignard Pure, an unregistered product for air treatment in indoor spaces (occupied and unoccupied) in Georgia to control the spread of the novel coronavirus (Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome Coronavirus 2 or SARS-CoV-2).

This public health exemption is amended to reference a newer label which was revised to correct a non-substantive administrative error. This revision to the originally issued authorization letter applies to condition #2 and is amended to read as follows:

2) The unregistered product, Grignard Pure (containing 52.25% triethylene glycol active ingredient (a.i.)), manufactured by Grignard Company, LLC, may be used under this exemption. All applicable use directions, restrictions, and precautions on the revised Section 18 label of **January 28**, 2021 must be followed unless otherwise modified in the authorization.

All other conditions and restrictions as stated in the January 14, 2021 authorization letter remain unchanged and still apply.
