NPDES authorization to discharge to waters of the United States

Under the Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) Code 4952, the applicant operates a Coushatta Tribe Casino's wastewater treatment plant serving approximately 3,000 people. The wastewater treatment plant has a design capacity of 0.8 million gallons per day (MGD).

The applicant is authorized to discharge from a facility located at 777 Coushatta Drive in the city of Kinder, Allen Parish, Louisiana. The outfall 001 located at Latitude 30° 32' 38" North and Longitude 92° 49' 9" West.

Discharges from the facility for the described activities are to an unnamed receiving water levee/ditch on tribal land to a tributary of the Calcasieu River thence to the Calcasieu River Basin in Waterbody Segment Code No. 030103. The known uses of the receiving water(s) are primary contact recreation, secondary contact recreation, fish and wildlife propagation, agriculture and outstanding natural resource water.

This is a proposed reissuance of the current NPDES permit issued September 30, 2016, with an effective date of October 1, 2016 and an expiration date of September 30, 2021. There are changes from the previous permit. A fact sheet is available.
