



## **Top 30 College & University**

As of October 25, 2021, the combined annual green power use of EPA's Top 30 College & University Partners amounts to nearly 3.8 billion kilowatt-hours of green power, which is equivalent to the annual electricity use of more than 351,000 average American homes.
