



How to apply for the DfE logo for products not currently certified

To apply for DfE certification, review is required from OPPT and OPP—please see the steps in the diagram below. For products containing DfE-approved active ingredients, OPPT review takes up to 8 weeks once the submission is received from the third-party reviewer, and the OPP registration and review process takes up to 5 months (depending on the Pesticide Registration Improvement Act (PRIA) action code). Non-DfE-approved active ingredients require additional review steps and an extended timeline.

In most cases, applicants should complete the OPPT review process before engaging with the OPP's Antimicrobials Division. If you would like to pursue concurrent review, EPA recommends that you first reach out to DfE_Support@abtassoc.com and your Antimicrobials Division product manager for an initial coordination meeting.
