<u>Reduce disparities</u>: Disparities exist in communities when they experience higher levels of pollution burden, sickness, and disease due to social inequities, lack of access to services, economic status, etc. For this LTPG, reducing disparities refers to working to decrease pollution burdens, increase benefits, and remove barriers for these overburdened communities. Disparities are things that can be clearly measured as outcomes on the ground in communities (such as blood lead levels, actual levels of pollution, presence/severity/proximity to contaminated land).

Number of milestones completed.

2a. Data Source:

The tracking of milestones is done via the regular process for reporting on Agency Priority Goal Action Plans. All milestones are tracked on a table within the action plan.
