



### STRATEGIC PLANNING PROCESS

#### PRELIMINARY WORK

- Fall 2021: Notified partners about strategic planning effort and asked for volunteers
- Strategic Planning Committee included:
  - Barr Lake and Milton Watershed Association
  - EPA
  - CSFS
  - USFS
  - Colorado Watershed Assembly
  - Denver Water
  - One World, One Water Center
  - Westervelt Ecological Services



#### STRATEGIC PLANNING PURPOSE

- The strategic plan is meant to provide SPRUWP with clear direction while leaving space for partners to have the autonomy to implement projects.
- The strategic plan should provide a roadmap but not be a detailed itinerary.






### STRATEGIC PLANNING OUTCOMES

#### SPRUWP MISSION

 Collaborate across jurisdictions and disciplines to engage communities, and to protect and restore the South Platte
Watershed from the Headwaters to the Denver Metropolitan Area (Colorado) and Watershed.



#### SPRUWP GOALS



Collaborate, educate and engage



Connect people with water



Protect and restore through leveraging resources



Communicate achievements and share technical information



### COLLABORATE, EDUCATE, AND ENGAGE STRATEGIES

- Advertise and host educational trainings for SPRUWP members
- Recruit new partners to promote outreach and education efforts
- Host a one-day conference/tour (annually or biannually)
- Continue to update partners about events and resources via email

# CONNECT PEOPLE WITH WATER STRATEGIES

- Promote educational efforts that help the public understand the source of their water supply
- Identify, consolidate, and compile existing public opinion survey data to create a comprehensive picture of public opinion in the South Platte Watershed
- Identify and amplify partners' programs and initiatives based on what they need from partners
- Develop tools to help people access water quality data
- Create and distribute resources to help partners plan and organize events (e.g., urban bike tours)



### PROTECT AND RESTORE THROUGH LEVERAGING RESOURCES STRATEGIES

- Track partner projects and initiatives across the watershed in an inventory
- Connect groups that are applying for funding to better leverage grant opportunities
- Connect groups that are creating models to try to align modeling efforts and promote modeling tools



# COMMUNICATE ACHIEVEMENTS AND SHARE TECHNICAL INFORMATION STRATEGIES

- Update the Water Quality Assessment Tool
- Take time to celebrate partner accomplishments
- Develop a communications plan for shared social media to celebrate wins and spread information on successes
- Promote and improve the SPRUWP website to share information

# STRATEGIC PLANNING PRIORITIZATION

- We can't do it all at once!
- The Strategic Planning Committee sent out a survey to prioritize the strategies\*
- 14 partners filled out the prioritization survey to indicate which strategies are highest priority to them.

# STRATEGIC PLANNING PRIORITIZATION OUTCOMES

- Top 5 highest priorities in order:
  - Promote educational efforts that help the public understand the source of their water supply.

  - Track partner projects and initiatives across the watershed in an inventory.
