

**INTERGOVERNMENTAL REVIEW INSTRUCTIONS
FOR NEW YORK APPLICANTS**

[EXECUTIVE ORDER 12372](#) - The Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) regulation, **[40 CFR Part 29](#)**, sets forth the Agency's obligations and procedures for consulting with and responding to views expressed by State and local elected officials on proposed EPA direct development activities, and applications submitted for EPA financial assistance.

EPA's Office of Grants and Debarment has published **[RAIN-2021-G02](#)** EPA Intergovernmental Review. This RAIN informs recipients and applicants about how to determine which EPA financial assistance programs and activities are subject to Intergovernmental Review (IR) requirements. Please note that programs which are subject to intergovernmental review for policy reasons rather than the requirements of Section 204 of the Demonstration Cities and Metropolitan Development Act and Section 401 of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act are identified with an asterisk (*).

On November 24, 2020, EPA issued a **[Federal Register Notice](#)** providing the list of EPA financial assistance programs and activities subject to intergovernmental review. The list reflects EPA's determination that state applicants for State Revolving Fund (SRF) capitalization grants meet their 40 CFR Part 29 IR responsibilities when the state complies with the public notice requirements for Intended Use Plans (IUP) in 40 CFR 35.3150 or 40 CFR 35.3555 as applicable. The IUP regulations implement the statutory requirements at CWA 1386(c) and SDWA 1452(b) for IUPs.

State applicants for SRF funding need not follow the IR procedures in 40 CFR Part 29. Please check box "c" on Standard Form 424 indicating that the application is not subject to the E.O. 12372 IR procedures per EPA's determination.
