

TRIBAL BASELINE WATER QUALITY STANDARDS


- Goal: Provide a common minimal protection standard for tribal waters
- Pre-proposal tribal consultation
 June 15-September 13, 2021
- On schedule:
 - Expect "early 2023" public proposal
 - Second tribal consultation opportunity.





TRIBAL RESERVED RIGHTS

- Rule published November 28, 2022.
- Two national tribal listening sessions January 24 & January 31, 2023.
- Request consultation by February 28, 2023.
- Written comments by March 6, 2023.



CWA 106 GUIDANCE REVISION

- January 13, 2021 EPA initiated consultation and coordination with Tribes to seek input on recommended changes
- January 13 March 15, 2021 first comment period
- April 21, 2021 solicited tribal participation in being a member of the workgroup
- June 13, 2022 August 15, 2022 second comment period
- January 23, 2023 Revised CWA 106 guidance was published

- Final rule
 - Signed Dec 2022
 - Published Feb 2023
 - Effective March 20, 2023
- Implementation outreach planned for Early 2023





CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 RULE

- Proposed 401 Improvement Rule published on June 9, 2022.
- Public Comment period closed on August 8, 2022.
- Agency intends to finalize the rule in Spring 2023.
