The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is announcing its proposed remedy under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), for the former Philadelphia Coke Company, Inc. facility located in Philadelphia, PA. The proposed remedy consists of capping residual soil contamination, installing vapor mitigation systems in the proposed building where necessary, implementing activity and use limitations for land and groundwater, and implementing a post-remedial care plan. The Facility was sold to BP Bridesburg, LLC on March 30, 2022, and is being redeveloped in conjunction with the cleanup plan.

Community members can comment on EPA's proposed remedy during the public comment period from August 10th to September 11th. Comments must be submitted in writing via mail or email to Kevin Bilash, the EPA Project Manager, and must be received prior to September 11. Information regarding EPA's proposed remedy is available on EPA's website below.
