Release of Scientific Information to the Public Questions (47-55)

The Review and Release of Scientific Information section was informed by both the 2016 Scientific Integrity survey and 2018 OIG survey, and new items were also developed. This section identifies perceptions related to the consistency, transparency, and timeliness with the clearance and review procedure. Further information is obtained with regards to understanding the interactions that have occurred with the and comfort level in speaking with the media in a professional capacity.

Throughout this survey, skip logic was implemented for certain questions to allow participants to skip parts of the survey that were irrelevant and focus on areas that were applicable. These questions have a total number of respondents less than the total number who completed this survey (< 2668). The table below outlines the questions that were impacted by the survey's skip logic:









Were you interviewed by a member of the media on the phone or virtual platform? (n=623)




52. Did an EPA public affairs/media representative join you on the call?



Did an EPA public affairs/media representative join you on the call? (n=150)






