Sec. 4-15. Right to file abatement suits.

Nothing in this chapter shall be construed to impair the right of the board of commissioners or the city attorney to file appropriate suits to abate a nuisance involving air pollution or to prosecute anyone for creating a nuisance or allowing a nuisance to continue or permitting a nuisance to exist. The board, with the approval of the city attorney, may in the name of the city institute action to abate a nuisance.
