Rule 17. General Provisions and Applicability for Process Gaseous Emissions Standards.

Original Reg

Rule 17.1. No person shall cause, suffer, allow or permit gaseous emission in excess of the standards provided in this regulation. For the purpose of this Rule 17 the term "process gaseous emission" shall mean any gaseous emission of an air contaminant to the ambient air other than that from fuel-burning equipment, incinerators or open burning.

Rule 17.2. Any person constructing or otherwise establishing an air contaminant source emitting gaseous air contaminants after the effective date of this regulation, which is not limited by a specific standard provided elsewhere in this regulation, shall install and utilize equipment and technology which is deemed reasonable and proper by the director.
