
1. WQX Project Status Report


a. WQX Status (Kevin)

March 1 had a WQX and WQXWeb release. We updated the QAQC services and made a suite of WQXWeb enhancements. This last Sprint was Sprint 2, we are now in Sprint 3 of the year. The most significant enhancement of the Sprint 2 release is the full updating of the WQX 3.0 schema, allowing for easy Unique Identifier renaming (Projects, Activities, Locations, etc.). Sprint 3's largest development ticket will include enhancements to the review report functions within the API, making the full schema retrieval available to API users.

c. WQX Helpdesk report (Shay)

160 tickets received in the last month, most common being user and organization requests. Working on some issue tracking. Currently working on a JIRA Confluence page which will hold all of our documentation, both processes and user documentation.

d. WQX - Comments, questions

Matthew - Will there be an Activity retrieval endpoint in the API? Answer - We try not to duplicate capabilities at the Portal. We do support detailed Activity Reports in the UI for the user's Organization, but not a list of Activity IDs matching a query across datasets. The current Activity Reporting functions will be made available in the API in the next sprint.

2. Water Quality Portal Status Report

a. WQP General Status Report (Candice/Lee)

There are a lot of changes coming. There is a banner on the WQP noting that USGS data has been frozen since March 11. This freeze will be in place until the USGS completes its data migration to the new system.

Profiles - In the month of April, we will be releasing the first 3 new WQX 3.0 profiles in a new UI. Those new profile services will serve the USGS data. Please do review these beta profiles as they become available in the UI, or now through the GraphQL service. We expect to release them to the Public some time in April. You should be able to find them from the current UI.

Three new Profiles released in Beta Now:

- 1. Monitoring Location Profile
- 2. Narrow Results PRofile
- 3. Full Physical Chemical Profile

Timeline:

Next week USGS will start releasing their data to the public in the WQX format. Data will be available on the USGS website first. There will be a UI that looks similar to the WQP for just USGS data. There is a <u>blog post</u> that will describe all these changes. In the coming weeks, we will be able to release additional Profiles as they are wrapped up. Please do review and provide

feedback (in the next few weeks, if possible) so we can try to make final edits before releasing these publicly.
