
PETITION FOR REVIEW

Circuit Rule 15, and Section 307(b)(1) of the Clean Air Act, 42 U.S.C. §7607(b)(1), for review of the final action of the United States Environmental Protection Agency (“EPA”) published in the Federal Register at 89 Fed. Reg. 39,798 (May 9, 2024) entitled “New Source Performance Standards for Greenhouse Gas Emissions From New, Modified, and Reconstructed Fossil Fuel-Fired Electric Generating Units; Emissions Guidelines for Greenhouse Gas Emissions From Existing Fossil Fuel-Fired Electric Generating Units; and Repeal of the Affordable Clean Energy Rule” (“Rule”).

**RULE 26.1 DISCLOSURE STATEMENT OF PETITIONER
ARIPPA**

Pursuant to Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure and Circuit Rule 26.1 and Circuit Rule 26.1, Petitioner Appalachian Region Independent Power Producers Association files the following statement:

Appalachian Region Independent Power Producers Association (“ARIPPA”) is a non-profit trade association that represents a membership primarily comprised of electric generating plants using environmentally-friendly circulating fluidized bed (“CFB”) boiler technology to convert coal refuse and/or alternative fuels such as biomass into alternative energy and/or steam, with the resultant alkaline ash used to reclaim mine lands. ARIPPA was organized for the purpose of promoting the general interests of its member facilities.

ARIPPA has no parent companies, subsidiaries, or affiliates that have issued shares or debt securities to the public, although specific individuals in the membership of ARIPPA have done so.

ARIPPA has no outstanding shares or debt securities in the hands of the public and has no parent company. No publicly held company has a 10% or greater ownership interest in ARIPPA.
