RE: The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region 6 Extension of Current Approval of A-Line TDS, Inc. and A-Line TDS Real Estate, LLC (“A-Line”) to Operate as a Commercial Storage Facility for Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCBs) and Operation of its Metal Reclaim Furnace (MRF) and Chemical De-chlorination Process to Dispose of PCBs at its Facility Located in Tonkawa, OK; EPA ID OKD987087020

Dear Mr. Fritz:

EPA is currently reviewing your renewal application and supplemental information submitted through June 18, 2024, for compliance with 40 CFR 761.65 and 761.70 and in conjunction with the information specified in the EPA’s October 2019 “Guidance for Applicants Requesting to Treat/Dispose of PCBs Using Incineration or An Alternative Method”. In addition, EPA is fulfilling its obligations under the Endangered Species Act and the National Historic Preservation Act.

EPA is in the process of reviewing A-Line’s PCB Trial Burn plan and other relevant documents. EPA will notify A-Line of its proposed determination regarding the plan, and, if the proposed determination is to approve the plan, EPA will publish the proposed trial burn plan approval for a 30-day public comment period.

To allow for full consideration of your submitted information and any subsequent public participation, EPA is continuing the extension of your current approval pursuant to regulations promulgated under section 6(e) of the Toxic Substances Control Act and codified in 40 CFR Parts 750 and 761. EPA finds that continuing the extension of your current approval for operation of the commercial storage facility, MRF, and chemical de-chlorination unit until December 31, 2024, does not present an unreasonable
