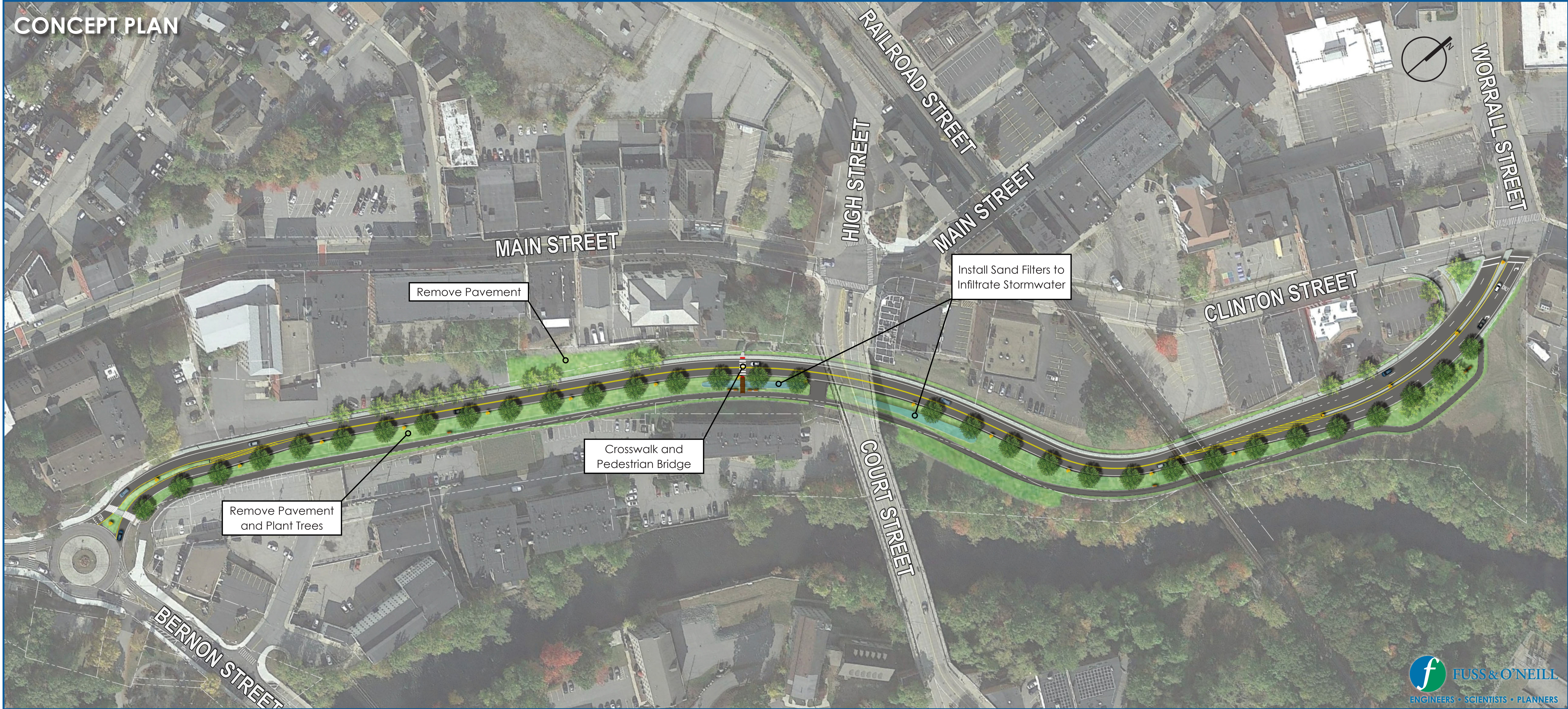


Truman Drive Green Infrastructure Parkway - Woonsocket, RI

PROJECT GOALS AND PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- Reduce pollutant loadings from stormwater to the Blackstone River (the river is designated as impaired by RIDEM) » Remove Pavement & Install Sand Filters
- Connect residents and businesses on Main Street to the Blackstone River » Install Crosswalk & Pedestrian Bridge
- Increase greenspace and reduce heat-island effects » Remove Pavement and Plant Shade Trees
- Improve the pedestrian experience along the Blackstone River bike path » Create Linear Park (Increase Greenspace & Improving Lighting)
- Traffic Control » The existing traffic patterns at the intersections with Bernon Street and Clinton Street will not be altered. Adjusting the orientation of the lanes will have a traffic calming effect, even though the posted speed limit will not be changed. The crosswalk will include rapid flashing beacons.
