


# What is a Project Sponsor?

The CIC seeks to provide direct and free technical support for underserved community project sponsors. A project sponsor is a representative from an organization who can directly advance and "owns" a project. Examples of Project Sponsors include: Tribal Nations, Non-Profits, Justice40 Organizations, Regional Coalitions, Academic Institutions, Developers, Faith-Based Organizations, Utilities, as well as Municipalities, Counties, and States.

#### **Project Sponsors**

- Match to Right Grants
