

Miscellaneous Uses of Carbonate

Subpart U, Greenhouse Gas Reporting Program



What Must Be Monitored?

Measure these parameters monthly at the facility level:

If	้าเรเกล	the	emission	factor	(FF)	method
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- \square Mass of each carbonate (CO₃²⁻) consumed (tons).
- ☐ Calcination fraction achieved for each CO₃²⁻, measured annually or default value of 1.0 (decimal fraction).

If using the mass balance method:

- \square Mass of each input CO_3^{2-} (tons).
- \square Mass of each output CO₃²⁻ (tons).
