Title: "Arctic Solid Waste Management Grant"

- 1. Battelle Memorial Institute (Battelle) hereby requests Offeror submit a written proposal based on the Statement of Work located at Attachment No. 1.
- 2. Type of Agreement: A Firm Fixed Price Subcontract/Purchase Order agreement is anticipated.
- 3. **Period of Performance**: The anticipated award of the subcontract is January 2025 with a period of performance extending through October 2026
- 4. <u>Award</u>: Any effort expended and any costs or expenses incurred by the Offeror as a result of this RFP shall be the sole responsibility of the Offeror. There is no obligation for Battelle to cover any Offeror costs incurred as a result of this RFP.

Evaluation Criteria and Award and Basis of Award

Best Value:

The subcontract/purchase order(s) resulting from this RFP will be awarded to the responsible offeror(s) whose offer conforms to this solicitation and is most advantageous to Battelle and its client, cost or other factors considered.

The following evaluation factors and sub-factors and respective weightings shall be used to determine the "best value" to Battelle and its client.

- 8. **Validity Date**: Offeror's proposal must remain valid for 120 days from the date of submission of the proposal and must be so stated in Offeror's proposal.
- 9. <u>Certifications/Questionnaires</u>: As part of Offeror's proposal and before any award may be made, the following certifications must be completed:
 - As a potential or existing supplier, Battelle is required to obtain the information contained in the Annual Supplier Representation and Certifications (Reps and Certs) as defined in FAR Part 9.104. <u>Certification and Disclosure Regarding Payments to Influence Certain Federal Transactions</u> (FAR 52.203-11)

- (a) Definitions. As used in this provision—"Lobbying contact" has the meaning provided at 2 U.S.C. 1602(8). - (b) Prohibition. The prohibition and exceptions contained in the FAR clause of this solicitation entitled "Limitation on Payments to Influence Certain Federal Transactions" (52.203-12) are hereby incorporated by reference it his provision.
- (c) Certification. The offeror, by signing its offer, hereby certifies to the best of its knowledge and belief that no Federal appropriated funds have been paid or will be paid to any person for influencing or attempting to influence an officer or employee of any agency, a Member of Congress, an officer or employee of Congress, or an employee of a Member of Congress on its behalf in connection with the awarding of this contract.
- (d) Disclosure. If any registrants under the Lobbying Disclosure Act of 1995 have made a lobbying contact on behalf of the offeror with respect to this contract, the offeror shall complete and submit, with its offer, OMB Standard Form LLL, Disclosure of Lobbying Activities, to provide the name of the registrants. The offeror need not report regularly employed officers or employees of the offeror to whom payments of reasonable compensation were made.
- (e) Penalty. Submission of this certification and disclosure is a prerequisite for making or entering into this contract imposed by 31 U.S.C. 1352. Any person who makes an expenditure prohibited under this provision or who fails to file or amend the disclosure required to be filed or amended by this provision, shall be subject to a civil penalty of not less than \$10,000, for each such failure.
